

CONCEPT NOTE Official Launch of ITRACOM Fertilizers Limited

Introduction:

ITRACOM Fertilizers Limited (IFL) is a newly established fertilizer manufacturing company in Dodoma. Tanzania, born from a partnership between East African stakeholders. Date and Venue

Key Activities
